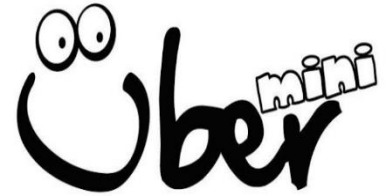




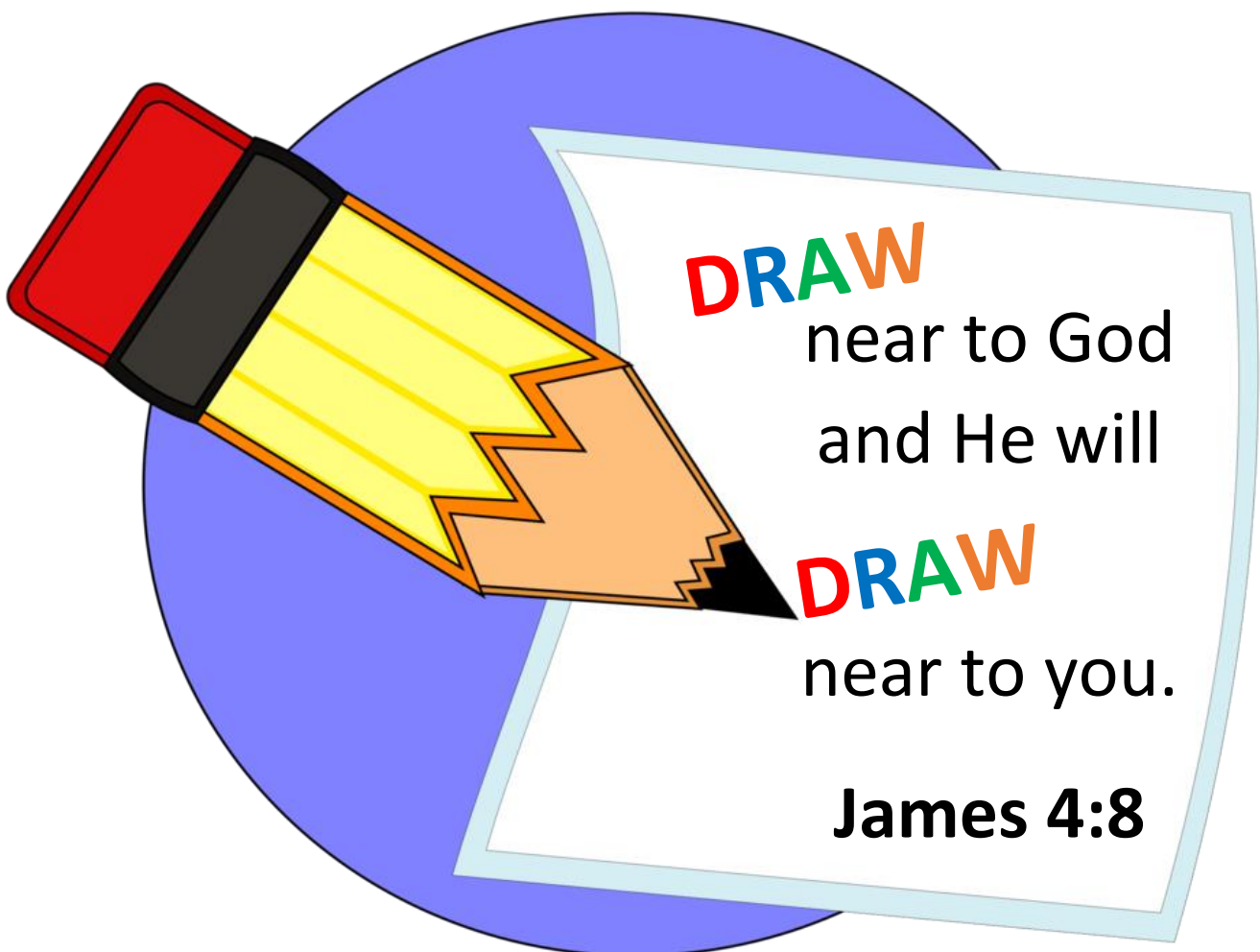

Memory verse puzzle

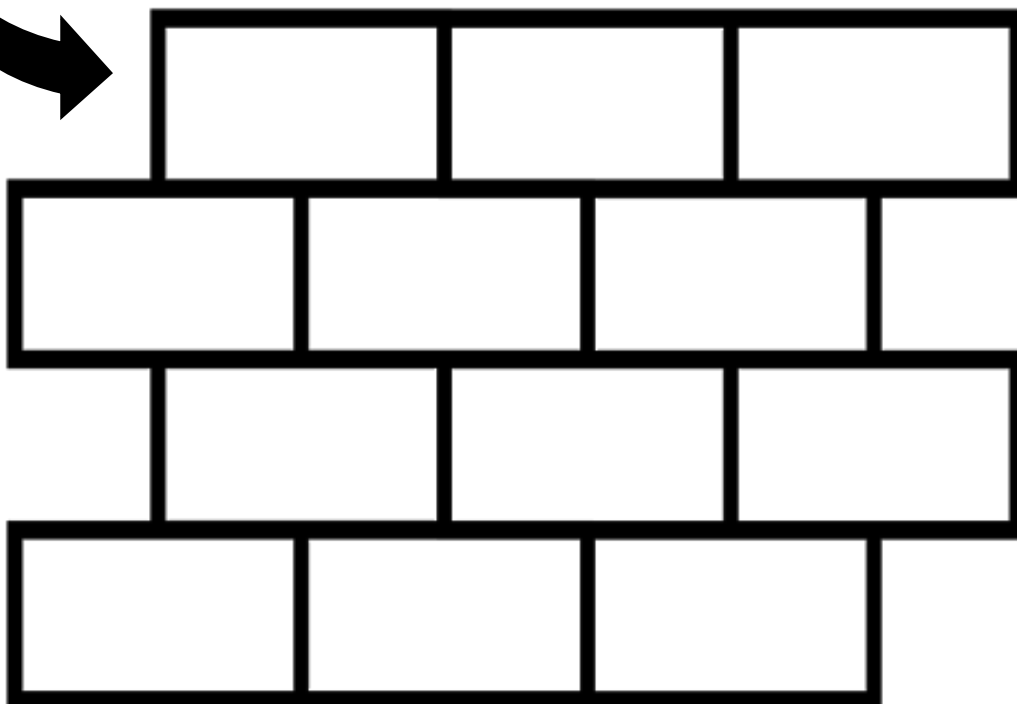
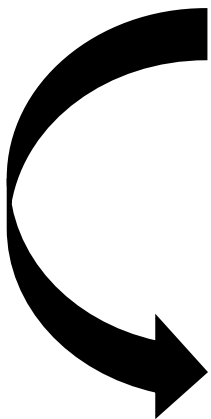
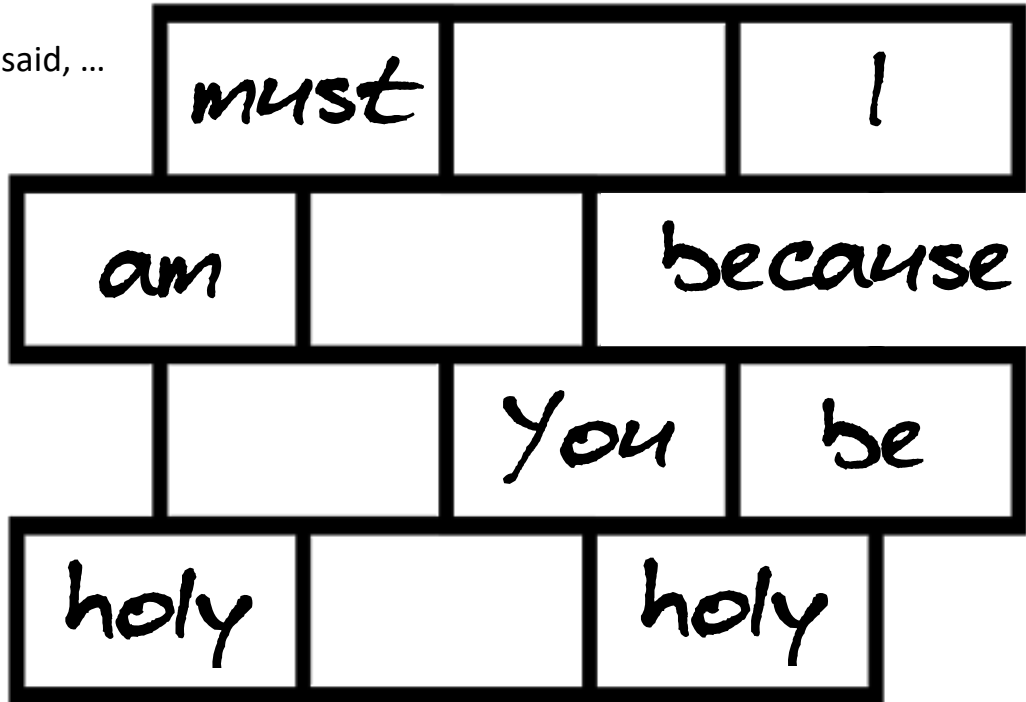
Complete the memory verse below by re-writing the words on the bricks in the correct order. If you need a clue, take your Bible and look it up.

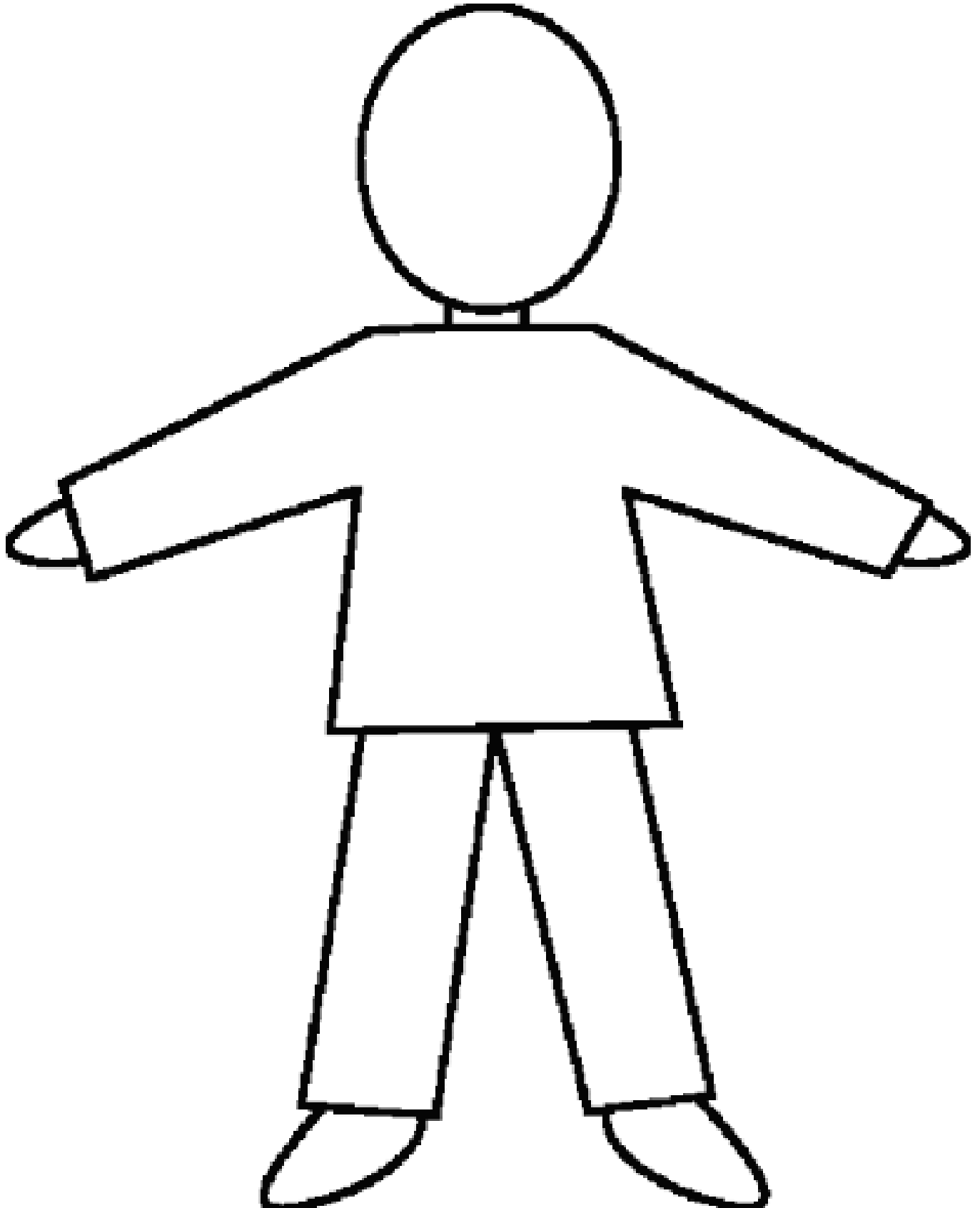

Candy Crystals

Science Experiment



Aim: To see the effects of evaporation.

Method

1. Half fill the mug with hot water.
2. Gradually stir in about two tablespoons of sugar until it is dissolved.
3. Cover the plates in foil and then pour two tablespoons of the liquid onto each plate.
4. Add a different drop of food dye to each liquid.
5. Leave the plates in a warm room. After three days, crystals will form.
6. If the plates have been kept in hygienic conditions, the crystals can be eaten if you wish!

You will need:

mug
hot water
sugar
two small plates
kitchen foil
coloured food dye

Teacher tip:

The water from the plates evaporates into the air and turns into water vapour - tiny water particles, spread so far apart that they are like a gas. Leaving the plates in a warm room speeds up the evaporation. Once the water has evaporated, only the sugar crystals are left.
